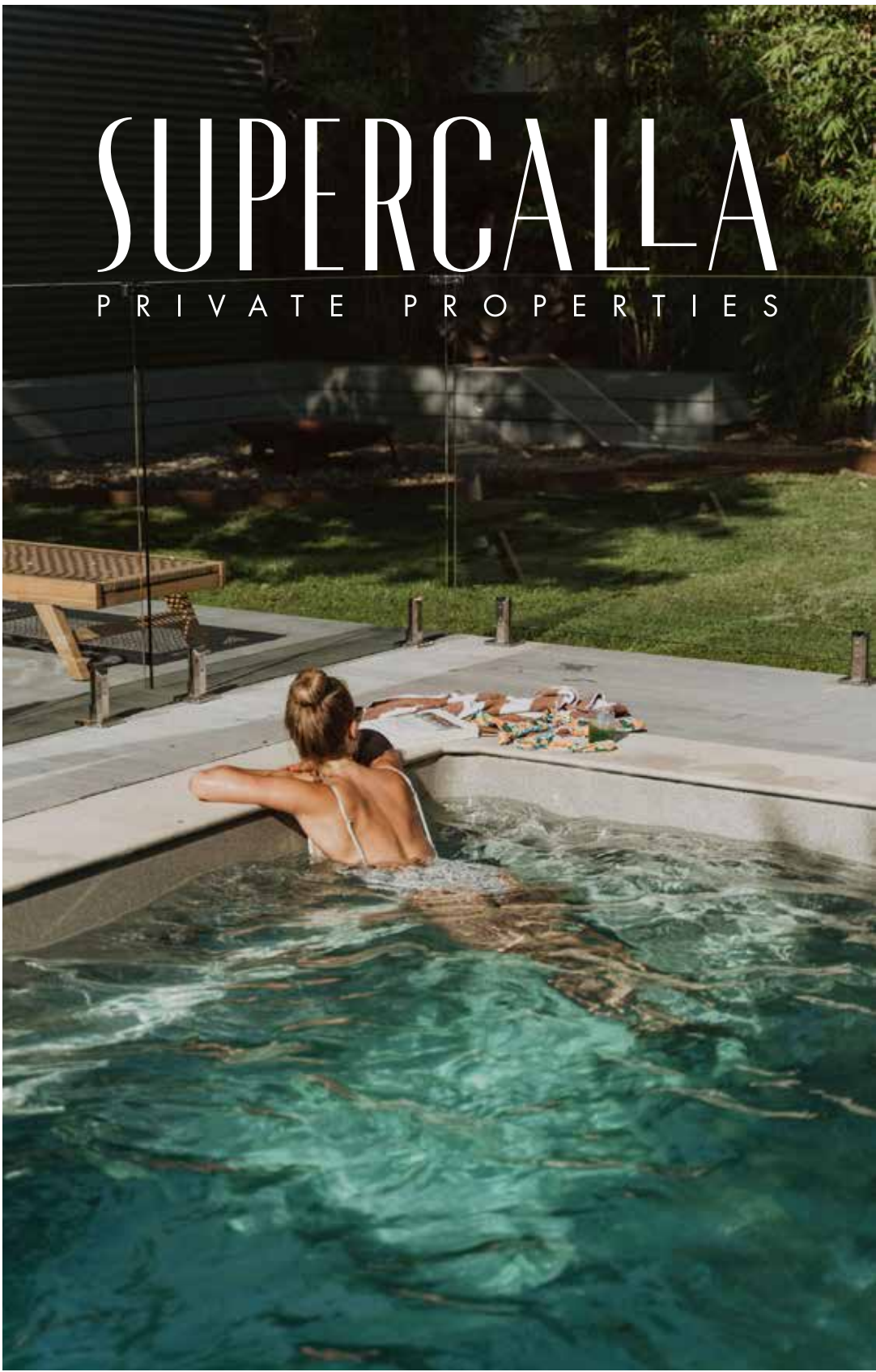

# walking on country

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**From whale songlines to bush food, connect deeply with Shoalhaven's Aboriginal culture.**

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**Booderee National Park** recently celebrated 30 years since its handback to the Wreck Bay Aboriginal community. Known in-language as the "bay of plenty," this stunning area covers the Bherwerre Peninsula in southern Jervis Bay. Visitors can enjoy white sand beaches, surf spots, whale watching, bushwalking, and some of Australia's best beachside camping. Engage with the Aboriginal Rangers and education programs, and always remember to tread lightly.

Follow ancestral footsteps with **Djiriba Waagura (Two Crows)** on the burri burri whale walk from **Murrays Beach**, tracing the



whale migration songline. You can also join their **warigala badha** cultural education walk along the **Shoalhaven River at Mundamia**, home of the red-bellied black snake. Bernie from **Djungga Kultural Tours** offers guided walks through the botanic gardens or Green Patch Beach, sharing stories of land, sea, bush foods, and wildlife.

In Nowra, **Blak Cede Gunyah** café is a First Nations women-led social enterprise serving bush foods with a modern twist. At Culburra Beach, **Mirritya Mundya** (Hungry Blackfish) offers Indigenous-inspired cuisine at their new restaurant and event space.

Join Aunty Deidre of **Bugiya Naway Buradja** (Yesterday, Today, Tomorrow) for weaving workshops or cultural walks. For deeper immersion, Uncle Noel and Aunty Trish Butler of **Nura Gunyu** host full-day experiences on Budawang Country. Their family, Felix and Angela of **Bungalin**, also offer bush food and cultural knowledge walks.

Further south, the **Ulladulla Local Aboriginal Land Council** leads guided walks along the **Coomee Nulunga Cultural Track** at Warden's Headland. Locally made gifts are available at the **Giriwa Garuwanga Gallery** on Deering Street.

Take a self-guided walk at Crookhaven Headland and view

carvings by **Uncle Noel Wellington** of the Jerrinja Community, depicting traditional animals and foods in a contemporary style.

**Gadhungal Marring** (Saltwater People) hosts cultural events like **Gangurang Corroboree** in Kangaroo Valley, **Baabaa-Gulli Murru tours** in Huskisson where they have a retail store with locally made art.

Many of these businesses offer bespoke experiences with Elders for small groups or special events, including smoking and welcome ceremonies. On your next visit to Shoalhaven, be sure to book an unforgettable Aboriginal Cultural Experience.

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**From farm to table, Shoalhaven's food culture celebrates local produce, slow food values, and its rich natural environment.**

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# eat local

Shoalhaven's food story is deeply rooted in place. This landscape doesn't just inspire - it produces. **Martins Ridge Farm** offers a closer look at regenerative farming, with charcuterie workshops and tastings of its free-range produce. The Shoalhaven River estuary is home to Australia's finest rock oysters, farmed here for over a century. You can buy them off the dock in Greenwell Point or stop by the **Jervis Bay Shellfish Market** for mussels grown sustainably in Jervis Bay.

Dining can be an experience in itself. **The Gunyah** at **Paperbark Camp** delivers treetop meals

in a bushland setting alive with birdlife, while **Bangalay Dining** pairs modern menus with native Australian flavours in a hatted restaurant by Seven Mile Beach. In Mollymook, **Rick Stein at Bannisters** showcases the South Coast's seafood, prepared simply and beautifully.

At **Milk HAUS** near Milton, a converted cheese factory is now a wholefoods eatery with kitchen garden, where seasonal menus highlight hyper-local produce. Nearby, **Cupitt's Estate** combines winery, brewery, restaurant, and luxury stays, with fresh ingredients drawn from its own garden and

surrounding farms. **Altar Wine Bar** combines a seasonal menu with a leafy garden setting, live music, and a strong focus on local wine.

Berry is home to **South on Albany**, where modern European flavours meet the region's finest seasonal produce. **Mountain Ridge Wines**, just outside town, invites visitors to slow down and take in the views from its hilltop position. The seasonal menu highlights ingredients grown on site or sourced from surrounding producers, all served with sustainability front of mind.

# wild waterways



**From surfing to kayaking, whale cruises to wakeboarding, Shoalhaven's waterways are an endless playground for adventure.**

Shoalhaven's coastline and rivers invite exploration in every form. Surf culture runs deep here, with schools across the region ready to get you on a board. Learn from a legend at **Pam Burridge Surf School** in Mollymook, try SUP surfing with **Coastal Paddle Surf**, or join **Jervis Bay Surf School**, **Mollymook Beach Surf School**, **Ulladulla Surf School** or **Currarong Surf School** for lessons that suit every level.

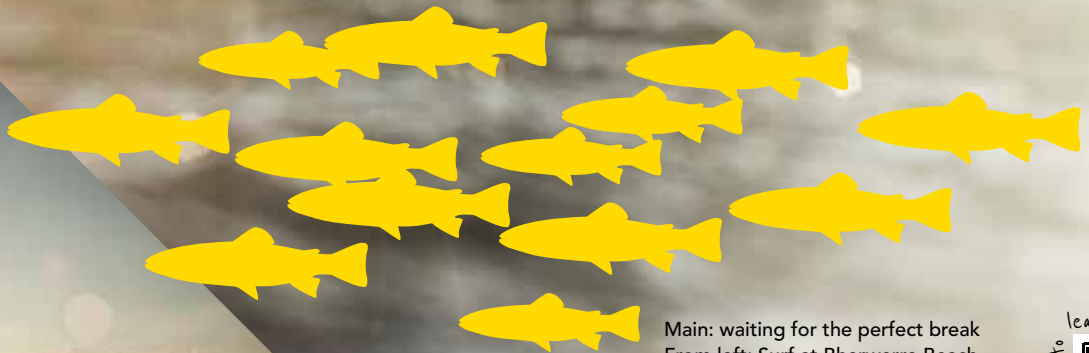
Paddlers will find plenty of choice. **Kangaroo Valley Kayaks**, **Valley Outdoors**, and **Kangaroo Valley Adventure Co.** offer canoe and kayak hire

or guided trips through dramatic escarpments and rivers. In Huskisson, **Jervis Bay Kayaks** and **Sea Kayak Jervis Bay** provide access to white sand beaches, marine life, and towering sea cliffs. Stand up paddleboards are also available from operators across Jervis Bay and Sussex Inlet.

For wildlife encounters, head out with **Jervis Bay Wild** or **Dolphin Watch Cruises** to see migrating whales and playful dolphins, or dive beneath the surface with **Dive Jervis Bay** and **Woebegone Freedive** for seal swims and reef adventures.

Looking for something new? Glide silently on an eFoil board in Jervis Bay with **Future Rides**, or hit the Shoalhaven River with **Shoalhaven Ski and Wake** for waterskiing, wakeboarding, and tubing. For family fun, **Walking on Water Watersports** deliver pedal boats to inlets and harbours, complete with water cannons for splash-filled battles. Or head to Erowal Bay and find **Jervis Bay Pedal Boat Hire** for some fun on the still waters of St Georges Basin.

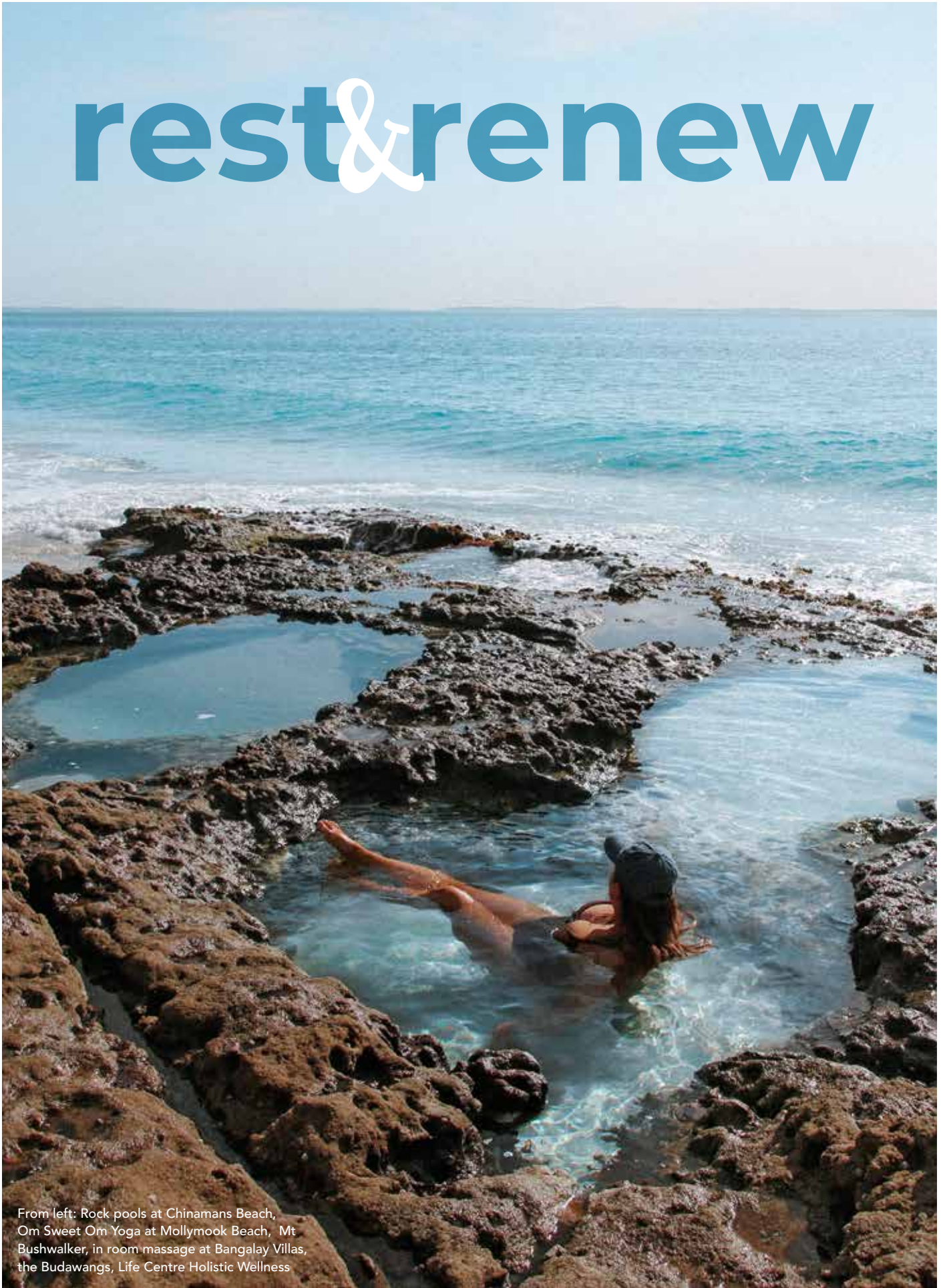
Whether you're chasing waves, paddling calm creeks, or exploring offshore, Shoalhaven turns every water adventure into a story to remember.

## Shoalhaven is a sanctuary for slowing down - where saunas, yoga, retreats and nature restore balance and calm.

Shoalhaven's wellness culture embraces both relaxation and renewal. In Milton, **The Heal Zone** pairs infrared saunas and cold plunges with breathwork and movement coaching, while Bewong's **Life Centre** offers saunas, float tanks, ice baths and holistic training surrounded by tranquil bushland.

Yoga and pilates studios dot the coast. **Worwong Jarvis Bay's** new wellness centre provides a peaceful place to breathe, move and restore. **Om Sweet Om** in

Milton provides mindful movement, from energising sunrise flows to restorative yin. For a deeper calm, **Healing Sounds Jarvis Bay** hosts sound baths at studios, beaches or even private holiday

homes, with crystal bowls and chimes melting away stress. Seek out one of the many massage and spa options across the region offering everything from Thai and hot stone massages to facials and beauty treatments to give your mind and body a fully rejuvenating experience. Mobile operators offer in-house treatments, bringing day spa vibes to your holiday accommodation. For a touch of indulgence try **Spa by the Sea** at Bannisters Mollymook or **Bangalay**

**Villas'** in-room treatments including massage and private yoga or meditation.

For those seeking extended escapes, **Bay and Bush** in Jarvis Bay provides cottages and glamping options with curated wellness activities, while **Paperbark Camp** combines luxury safari-style tents with treetop dining, open-air baths and the soothing soundtrack of nature.

Sometimes, wellness simply means rewilding yourself in Shoalhaven's vast outdoors with 100 beaches, endless walking trails, and 70% of the region classified as state forest or national park, there's always space to slow down, unplug, and reconnect.

# white sands to starry skies ✨

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From Honeymoon Bay to Huskisson, Jervis Bay is full of wildlife, wonder, and warm welcomes – day or night, on land or at sea.

**Jervis Bay** is where nature puts on a show, both above and below the waterline. Home to some of the whitest sand in the world, and over 200 square kilometres of **Jervis Bay Marine Park**, this coastal gem is a sanctuary for both wildlife and wanderers. Whether you're cruising alongside dolphins with **Jervis Bay Wild** or cycling the **Round the Bay track**, Jervis Bay invites you to slow down and soak it all in. When night falls, **Jervis Bay Stargazing** offers an immersive experience where the

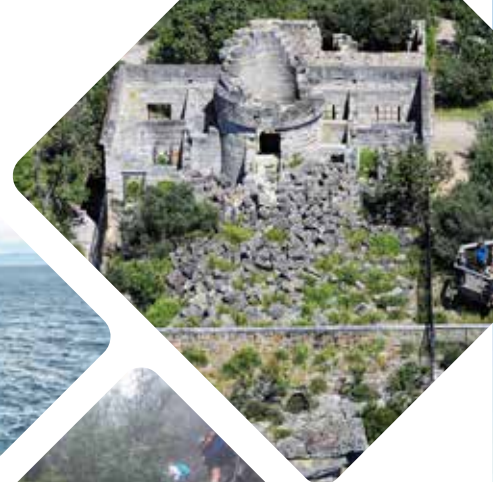
southern sky becomes your ceiling and the constellations your guide.

Join a boat tour to spot migrating whales, playful dolphins, and fur seals, or paddle quietly through calm waters where rays and turtles glide beneath. If you're feeling adventurous, dive below the surface with **Wobegone Freedive** or **Dive Jervis Bay** and swim with the whales across the winter months. The contrasting headlands of the north and south offer two distinct ways to experience the bay's beauty, both

with secluded charm and vibrant waterfront villages.

With flat terrain and waterside pathways connecting the towns and villages, exploring the bay is as easy as it is enjoyable. NSW's Top Tiny Tourism Town **Huskisson** sits alongside **Vincentia**, **Callala Bay**, **Sanctuary Point** and **St Georges Basin** as great places to stop for a spot of boutique shopping, or café hopping, and as an accommodation base for exploring the 16 white sand beaches nearby.

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# nature's stage

Shoalhaven is made for big views in breathtaking places. Along the coast, lighthouses double as iconic landmarks and perfect whale watching points. **Warden Head Lighthouse** in Ulladulla offers sweeping views south to Bawley Point. In Jervis Bay, **Point Perpendicular** towers 80 metres above the ocean, a dramatic cliff-edge lookout providing coastal views far and wide. Also on the northern peninsular **Abrahams Bosom Reserve** provides access to these famous sea cliffs through the spectacular **Gosangs Tunnel**. There's nothing quite like crawling through a cave and emerging on a cliff face to make you feel

like a trailblazer. On the southern headland, the haunting **Cape St George Lighthouse** ruins in **Booderee National Park** are steeped in history, standing sentinel over the sea.

For inland panoramas, **Three Views walking track** in Morton National Park leads to cliffside vantage points over Lake Yarrunga, Tallowa Dam and the Shoalhaven River. More adventurous travellers can tackle **Pigeon House Mountain Didthul**, a sacred site for the Aboriginal people and one of the South Coast's most rewarding climbs, with summit views stretching as far as Jervis Bay.

The escarpment that frames Shoalhaven is home to some of NSW's most striking waterfalls. **Tianjara Falls** plunges 65 metres into wild bushland, while **Granite Falls** descends a granite face framed by tall eucalypts. Further north, **Fitzroy Falls** drops over 80 metres, with a visitor centre, boardwalks, and sweeping views of Kangaroo Valley. **Carrington Falls** is another stop on the journey, where the Kangaroo River tumbles dramatically off the Budderoo plateau into rainforest below, best admired from one of several lookouts.

# grounded *thrills*



## Discover Shoalhaven on foot, by bike or from the treetops – where every path leads to a new adventure.

Shoalhaven's diverse landscapes make it the perfect place to lace up your boots and explore. Around Nowra, **Ben's Walk** loops along the **Shoalhaven River** through gorges, forest, and grassy banks, with a suspension bridge crossing and **Hanging Rock lookout** offering sweeping views. In Jervis Bay, the **White Sands Walk** delivers exactly what its name promises - dazzling beaches, aqua-blue water, and a chance to spot dolphins along the way. Further south, the new **Southern Headlands Walk** stretches 20km from **Narrawallee** to **Burrill Lake**, linking cafes, wildflowers, and coastal villages. **Morton National Park** is a bushwalking mecca, home to the iconic **Pigeon House Mountain Didthul** as well as lesser-known trails of **Mt Bushwalker** and **Florence Head** that lead to equally rewarding views.

Climbers can test their skills at **Indoor Climb South Coast** in Huskisson and **The Nest Climbing Gym** in South Nowra, with bouldering and rope climbs for all levels. Head outdoors with **Climb Nowra**, **Outdoor Raw** or **Valley Outdoors** to tackle world-class sandstone cliffs that rise above the Shoalhaven River and Jervis Bay sea walls.

Cyclists have plenty of trails to choose from. Mountain bikers can hit fast-flowing single tracks in **Currambene** and **Woodburn State Forests**, while road and leisure riders can follow Jervis Bay's coastal paths. **Kangaroo Valley Adventure Co.** can sort you out with guided and self-guided mountain bike adventures. While families can explore one of many pump tracks across the region.

Families and thrill-seekers alike can head to **Shoalhaven Zoo**, home to both native and exotic animals, before swinging into action next door at **Treetops Adventure** Nowra, where zip-lines and treetop obstacle courses overlook sandstone cliffs.

With over 300,000 hectares of national parks and state forests to explore, Shoalhaven offers adventure at every turn.

# art & soul

Discover Shoalhaven's rich arts and culture, from landmark museums and galleries to hands-on workshops and local artisan treasures.



Shoalhaven's cultural landscape is as diverse as its scenery. Discover **Bundanon**, the celebrated art museum and nature wonderland on Arthur Boyd's former estate, offering world-class exhibitions, an historic homestead, and creative workshops. In Nowra, **Shoalhaven Regional Gallery** presents an ever-changing program of contemporary and traditional works, while the **Shoalhaven Entertainment Centre** stages live theatre, concerts, and community events. Step into local history at **Meroogal**, a 19th-century timber house kept alive by generations of women, or explore Australia's naval

aviation story at the **Fleet Air Arm Museum**. On the coast, the **Jervis Bay Maritime Museum** combines heritage vessels, exhibitions, and mangrove boardwalks with insights into Indigenous culture.

Creative experiences abound across the region. In Berry, try your hand at pottery with **David Collins** or join a silversmithing class at **Appleye Jewellery Designs**. **Luxury Clay Experiences** deliver tailored workshops at your accommodation, while Milton's **House of Jules Art Studio** offers painting and drawing classes for groups and individuals. In Kangaroo Valley, learn the craft of stained glass at **Kangaroo Valley**

**Leadlights** workshops with local artist Lance Brown.

For unique finds, Shoalhaven's artisan stores celebrate local creativity and community. **Co.LAB** in Berry showcases works from more than 50 small businesses, while **The Collective Beat** connects makers and shoppers across their various South Coast locations. Throughout Shoalhaven's towns, galleries and boutiques brim with local art, jewellery, homewares, and handmade treasures.

Every corner of Shoalhaven offers a new way to experience art and culture.

# grand travel

## Shoalhaven's drives reward every detour, with lookouts, villages, and experiences that make the road trip unforgettable.

The **Grand Pacific Drive** links the coast to the highlands. Starting south of Sydney, traverse the Royal National Park and the sweeping curves of Sea Cliff Bridge before heading into Shoalhaven. Stop in **Berry** for boutiques and country cafés, explore **Shoalhaven Heads** for its estuary and surf beaches, and continue through **Nowra** for river walks and art galleries. Continue to **Jervis Bay**, home to

white sand beaches and marine life, before looping back inland through misty **Kangaroo Valley**, with **Hampden Bridge** and **Fitzroy Falls** offering photo-worthy breaks.

If you're travelling between Sydney and Melbourne, the coastal route is made brighter by Shoalhaven's southern towns. **Milton** is a heritage village with hatted dining, quirky shops, and markets tucked among historic streets. Nearby **Mollymook** boasts ocean-view stays, golf courses, and safe swimming spots, while surfers tackle both reef and beach breaks. Just south, **Ulladulla** blends working harbour charm

with modern food culture – from seafood fresh off the trawlers to craft breweries, cafes and restaurants.

For travellers from Canberra, **Main Road 92** is both the quickest and one of the most scenic routes to the coast. Along the way, cross the Shoalhaven River at Oallen Ford and carry onto the small village of Nerriga where you can stop at the iconic **Nerriga Pub** and snap a selfie with Nerriga Ned across the road. Seasonal treats await at the **Sassafras Nut Farm**, while **Tianjara Falls** offers a dramatic sandstone escarpment lookout. From there, it's only a short drive to Shoalhaven's stunning coastline.

Dotted across the Shoalhaven, you'll find taprooms and cellar doors that give a true taste of the region. Whether it's locally grown, brewed or distilled, this is a place where every sip tells a story. With rolling vineyards, laid-back breweries, and bold distilleries, the region invites you to slow down, and savour the moment.




With over a dozen cellar doors to explore, the region is home to passionate winemakers championing the South Coast's unique terroir. You'll find stunning views, seasonal menus, and warm hospitality at every stop. Enjoy a tasting or a long lunch overlooking the vines while taking in the endless views or settle in for the night, with some wineries offering stunning on-site accommodation.

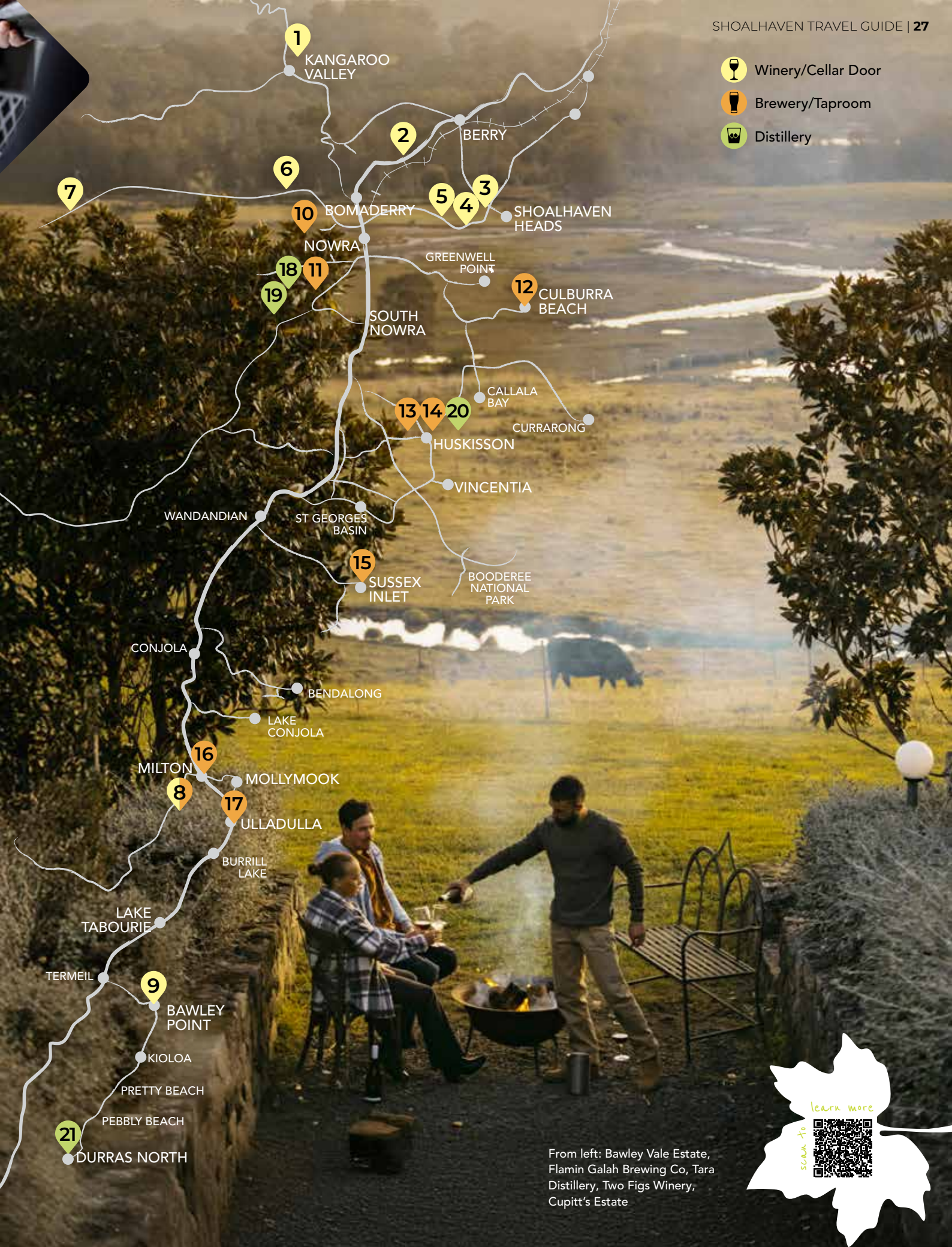
Whether it's a refreshing lager after a surf or a bold IPA by the fire, Shoalhaven's breweries serve up more than just great beer. Expect tasty bites, laid-back tunes, and a chance to connect with locals.

The region's distillers welcome you in with open doors and open bottles – from gins layered with native herbs to velvety vodkas and bright, zesty limoncello. Take a behind-the-scenes tour, hear the stories behind each spirit, and enjoy a tasting in the setting that inspired the flavours.

## From boating and fishing to a round of golf, Shoalhaven is made for outdoor leisure and adventure.

Shoalhaven's waterways are a playground for boaters and anglers. In Jervis Bay, **Anchors Aweigh Boat Hire** makes it easy to explore at your own pace, from calm-water cruising to fishing trips or snorkelling among hidden coves. In **Sussex Inlet**, locals offer plenty of ways to get on the water: **Sussex Inlet Pontoons** provide floating fun for families and groups, while **Sussex Inlet Boat Hire** delivers safe, no-licence-needed boats for fishing or simply soaking up the scenery. For something festive, keep an eye out for **Tides and Tunes**, who do after dark boat parties with **Dolphin Watch Cruises**.

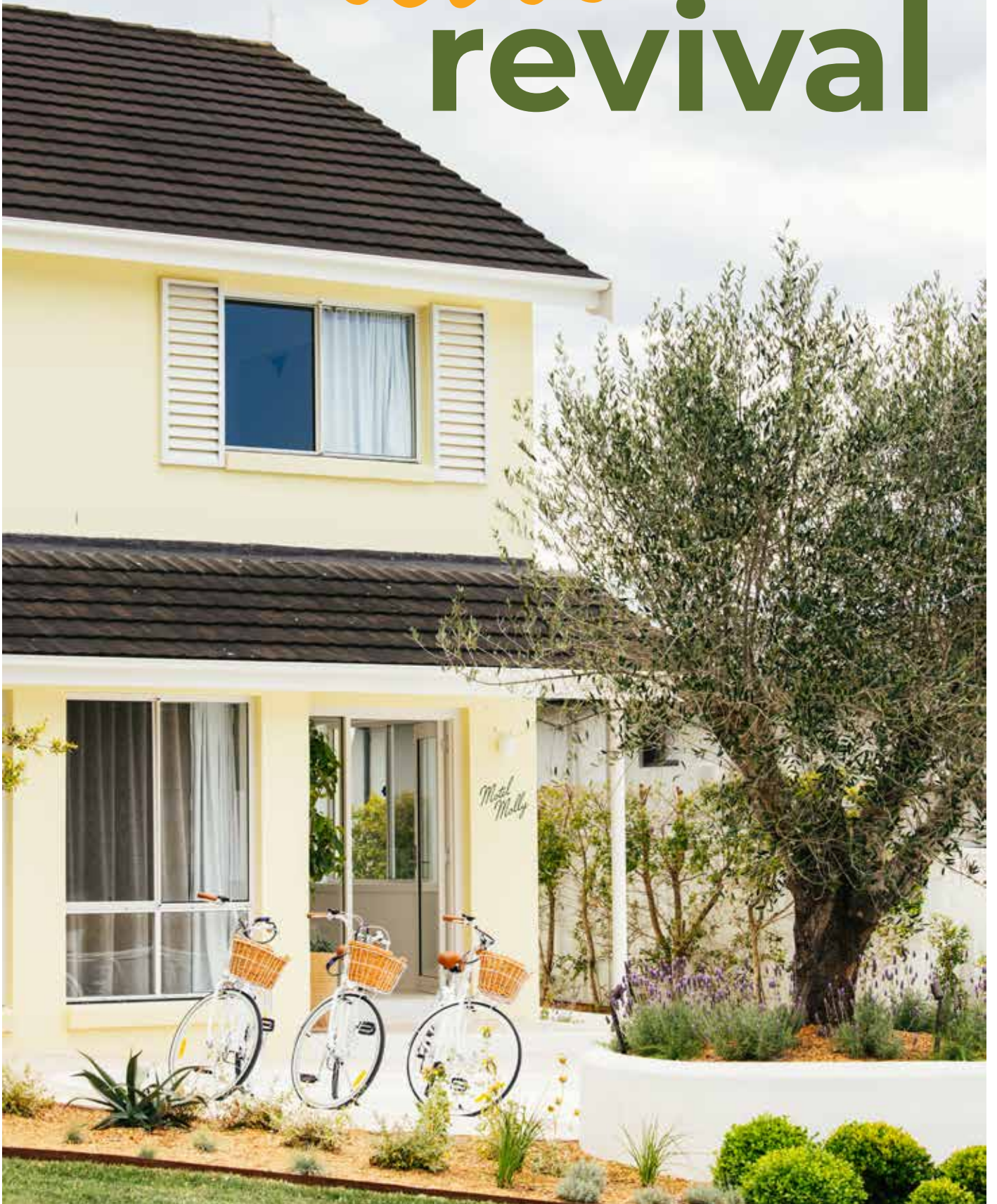

## From whale watching to wine tasting, Shoalhaven is home to experiences everyone can enjoy.

**Jervis Bay Wild's** accessible Port Venture is the perfect way to explore the bay as part of a dolphin cruise or winter whale watching adventure. There is a level ramp for embarkation and a hoist so you can enjoy summer boom-netting. Before you step aboard, the **Fishermens Wharf Cafe** is a great place to watch the boats and have a bite to eat.

There are 100 beaches in Shoalhaven, but **Nelson Beach** in Jervis Bay tops the list for those mindful of mobility. The fully paved **Round the Bay path** between Huskisson and Vincentia meets a raised viewing platform that is wheelchair-friendly. Nearby at **Plantation Point Reserve**, a 'changing places' bathroom assists those with high support needs. If you're keen to get down to the water, specialised beach wheelchairs are available for hire through the **Shoalhaven City Council** website at a variety of locations.

The Shoalhaven Wine Coast offers a range of cellar door, dining and tasting experiences.

**Two Figs Winery** sits atop a hill overlooking the Shoalhaven River, while nearby **Mountain Ridge Winery** offers mountain views, live music and paddock to plate dining. **Cupitt's Estate** welcomes all with easily accessible dining and deck spaces for tastings, as well as a fully accessible villa for overnight stays.

For a cultural experience, head to **Shoalhaven Regional Gallery** which is wheelchair-accessible, and caters to visitors with hearing loss and mobility issues. See a show or pop into the **Visitor Centre** at **Shoalhaven Entertainment Centre**, a stand-out venue for those with specific needs, featuring a hearing loop, environmental cues for those with vision impairment and a sensory map to assist in orientation of the centre. At the **Jervis Bay Maritime Museum**, explore the elevated 1.4 kilometre **Mangrove Boardwalk** and marvel at the abundance of fish, crabs and other critters in this unique ecosystem.

Everyone can play in Shoalhaven with **Boongaree Nature Play Park** in Berry, specifically designed to be inclusive and accessible for visitors with disabilities, featuring wheelchair-friendly pathways and amenities. Further south **Livvi's Place** Mollymook Beach playground provides inclusive play with plenty of options, as well as the nearby coastal pathway and eateries.

Even when skies turn grey, Shoalhaven is brimming with family-friendly activities. Local cinemas provide the perfect escape: The 1930s Art Deco **Roxy Cinema** in Nowra recalls the golden age of film, **Huskisson Pictures** charms with its intimate seaside setting, and **Arcadia Cinemas** in Ulladulla screens the latest blockbusters.

Indoor play centres keep energy levels high. **Wally's World** in South Nowra boasts multi-level climbing frames, ball pits and slides, while **Play-O-Rama** in Worrigeo combines giant jumping castles, mazes and toddler play zones, with a café for parents to recharge. In

Ulladulla, **Funland** is a lively indoor amusement centre filled with dodgems, arcade games and laser hunts, plus foam mazes and slides for younger kids.

Bowling is a classic rainy-day pastime. **Shoalhaven City Lanes** in Bomaderry features 16 lanes, an arcade and pool tables, while the **Dunn Lewis Centre** in Ulladulla adds climbing walls, tenpin lanes, and a gallery of shells, rocks and local crafts. first in Australia to be certified under Best Aquaculture Practices. **PhycoHealth** harnesses the healing properties of seaweed, creating a range of products rooted in locally grown and harvested ingredients which offer a myriad of benefits through food and skincare.

Eco-certified stays like **Paperbark Camp**, **The Cove**, **Crystal Creek Meadows** and **Broger's End** offer a softer footprint without skimping on comfort. And if you're keen to explore outdoors, low-impact operators like **Sea Kayak Jervis Bay** and **Region X** will get you up close to the region's wild side.

EV chargers are now part of the landscape, from holiday parks to cellar doors such as **Silos Estate** with 16 charging stations, making it easier to travel consciously. Wherever you go, small actions make a big difference – drive slowly for wildlife, give nesting shorebirds space, and resist the urge to feed native animals.

Whether you're here for the locally grown and sourced food, the rolling green hills or the many beaches, the Shoalhaven invites you to travel with care, leaving the region just as beautiful as you found it.

**Hayden's Pies** in Ulladulla and **Earnest Arthur** in South Nowra are highway institutions, serving everything from classic pies

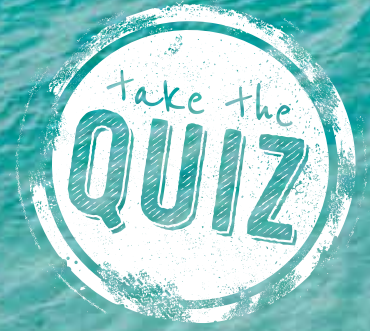
to adventurous specials. Burrill Lake's **Lagom Bakery** pairs slow-fermented sourdough with coffee and lake views worth lingering over.
